



COVID19 On-Campus Safety for Controlling the Spread of Contagious Diseases

With this in mind, we are following recommendations from the Florida Department of Education, the Florida Department of Health, and the Center for Disease Control (<http://www.fldoe.org/em-response/index.shtml>) while also keeping our eyes and hearts focused on our Healer, Jesus.

Although at this time Naples Christian Academy is temporarily closed to the general public as recommended by the Governor of Florida, essential staff are available to assist you by calling 239-455-1080 between the hours of 10am-2pm, from Monday through Thursday. Of course, you may always reach us via email at any time.

As the safety of our visitors, families, staff and students is our first priority, we have suspended our "Walk-In Wednesday" opportunities at this time. However, we are scheduling one-on-one tours of our fully sanitized campus facilities, which are available by calling ahead to our main line (239-455-1080). We will require the use of masks and social distancing during the tour. Staff members are also available to answer any questions via phone or Zoom call, as well as through Facetime.

Also during this time, students are participating in remote learning directed by the faculty of NCA. Our first curbside pick-up for learning materials was on 3/18 and these will continue through the end of May.

We continue to coordinate with our local health officials, the Florida Department of Health, the Florida Department of Education and Collier County Emergency Management within the guidance of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).



When it is time to return to school, we want parents, students, and staff to feel safe and comfortable at NCA.

In order to minimize the risk of infectious diseases of all types (cold, flu, COVID19, etc.), the staff of Naples Christian Academy has been working tirelessly in the cleaning and sanitizing of the building.

- Our maintenance staff is performing routine cleaning daily, including frequently touched surfaces.
- Maintenance has also performed deep-cleanings of every room in the school, including using Clorox wipes on doorknobs, pencil sharpeners, desktops, chairs, panic bars (where installed), common-use pencils, markers, etc.
- Staircases and elevators have been sanitized.
- New air conditioning filters have been installed throughout the buildings and will be changed every three months.
- When interacting with families during drop-off and pick-up days, teachers have worn gloves and masks and have adhered to social distancing norms.
